## Cleaning recommendations

FLAMLINER-qualityies are made of 100% fibre glass with a coloured finish and top coat

FLAMLINER-fabrics are dyed with pigments and these pigments do not penetrate the glass fibre. The colour is more a finishing or coating which sits on the surface of the fabric. Coloured Flamline products can lose colour or fade if they are stressed in processing, cleaning or washing.

**Do not rub, scrub, wring, bleach, boil or chemical clean the FLAMLINER products!**

FLAMLINER installations should be carefully cleaned with a vacuum cleaner or dry brush only!

Washing of FLAMLINER-installations should be avoided because it may influence the colour, appearance and softening of the product! Test washing is highly recommended!

If washing cannot be avoided please follow the care instructions mentioned below:

- Remove hooks and weights, washable runners may be left in the curtain.
- Curtains should be washed at max. 30°C using a delicate programme.
- Machine load must not exceed 50 %.
- Mild detergent free of brightener and bleaching agent may be used sparingly.
- Spin only at a low speed.
- Hang up the fabric in damp condition.
- Please do not use a tumble dryer at all!
- FLAMLINER-fabrics should not be ironed.
